The annual bicycle ride across the state of Georgia began in 1980 under the guidance of Dot Moss. Dot received her inspiration for the tour from Iowa's RAGBRAI. Georgia's event started out as the Great GASBE (Georgia's Annual State Bicycling Event). The 1st ride began in Savannah and ended in Columbus. From Savannah the group traveled to Metter and received red carpet treatment. Dublin, Perry, and Thomaston were the next stops. In Thomaston a tradition began of camping on football fields. Of the 120 riders who left Savannah, 60 weary and saddle-sore cyclists arrived in Columbus completing the 300 miles of the first GASBE.

1984

By 1984, the tour had grown to over 287 cyclists and traveled a 335 mile route which began in Helen, Georgia. Other host cities included Clarkesville, Hartwell, Louisville and Springfield. The city of Hartwell treated the riders to a street party where the Mayor spent the evening dancing with cyclists who had pedaled all day. GASBE V was the last tour to use that name. Dot Moss retired from the director's position and took the tour name with her. The event had grown too big for one person to plan, direct and coordinate. As GASBE V ended, Georgia's bicycling tour was nameless and leaderless.

1985

Jerry Colley organized a meeting of interested people and kept the ride alive. The Coastal Bicycle Touring Club of Savannah volunteered to serve as the coordinating club for the 1985 tour. The name, Bicycle Ride Across Georgia (BRAG), was adapted. With Ann Glendenning leading the group, some 480 cyclists were

treated to a ride which followed the route of Sherman's March to the Sea, visiting Stone Mountain, Hard Labor Creek State Park, Milledgeville, Louisville, Richmond Hill and finally to Savannah.
